This event will be held outdoors regardless of weather!

Test/Trial location will be available from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. or one hour after conclusion of Test/Trial.

Please note that Indiana is in the EST time zone and now observes daylight savings time.

No unentered dogs (except set-out dogs) will be allowed on the official Test/Trial grounds.

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED.

Please bring your own chairs and shade. Smoking in designated areas ONLY.

Signs that are posted will be strictly enforced

Schedule will be provided. Bitches in season will be allowed, but will be moved to the end of the class in Tests. Please notify Test Secretary if your bitch is in season. ALL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RULES REGARDING CONDUCT WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after closing of entries.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY.

NO CONDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED & JUDGE & STOCK SELECTED IF CHOICES ARE OFFERED

Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Release Form on the reverse side of the entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Owners or their Agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the Test/Trial arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean, tidy condition & to pick up after their dogs.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent (unless replaced by an Alternate), disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Test/Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the Test/Trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Entries close at Secretary's address at 6:00 PM Friday, May 23rd, 2008, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled altered or substituted. DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO TEST/TRIAL LOCATION

Dogwood Farm can be reached easily from Attica, by taking 41 North out of Attica (41 merges with US. 28 and US. 55). Go over the Wabash River then turn right (north) onto Hwy 55. Take Hwy. 55 to CR 250 N. There is a golf course on the corner. Turn left (west) on to CR 250 N, go to CR 225W and turn right (north), go to CR 300 N and turn left (west). Go to Watson Hill Rd and turn left (south), go just over a mile, the farm will be on the right.

If you are coming from the North out of Pine Village (16 miles west of West Lafayette on State Road 26) take State Road 55 south out of Pine Village to CR 250 N (6.9 miles) and turn right (west). There is a golf course on the corner. Turn left (west) on to CR 250 N, go to CR 225W and turn right (north), go to CR 300 N and turn left (west). Go to Watson Hill Rd and turn left (south), go just over a mile, the farm will be on the right.

From Danville, IL take I-74 east (just as you cross the state line), take the IN-63 exit North toward NEWPORT/W. LEBANON. Continue to follow IN-63 North for 17.1 miles. Turn RIGHT onto W 200 N. (There is a Highway garage at that little exit.) Go a short way and then it crosses a little highway - W 200 N becomes Twin - Bridges Road. Go 1.2 miles. Turn LEFT – then LEFT again onto WATSON HILL RD. Go about a 0.6 miles to the top of the hill. The farm with the huge white barn is Dogwood.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damages to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Herding Test or Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

I (we) will pay for any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock by my (our) dog. In case of injury to any stock caused by the dog entered, I (we) will assume total responsibility for any damage. I (we) agree to pay the full market value (Sheep - \$150.00, Ducks - \$35.00) of the injured animal in case of serious injury, or the veterinarian bill if the injury is slight.
