Note to Exhibitors

- Entry fees are \$18 for the 1st class and \$18 each additional class per dog per day and includes \$3 AKC recording fee per class.
- Entries must be the AKC *specified size* and include signature, fees, and *agreement on the back* or they will be returned to the exhibitor.
- Entries are opened upon receipt and exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and LEGIBLE information on entry forms as well as correct fees; illegible or incomplete entries WILL be returned. Fill in all the blanks, please.
- No refunds given under \$10 for your wrong addition. Checks returned from your bank will incur a \$20 charge and all future entries will be on a *cash only* basis.
- You MUST designate a Height at Withers.
- Per AKC regulations, only dogs 15 months of age or older are eligible to enter this trial.

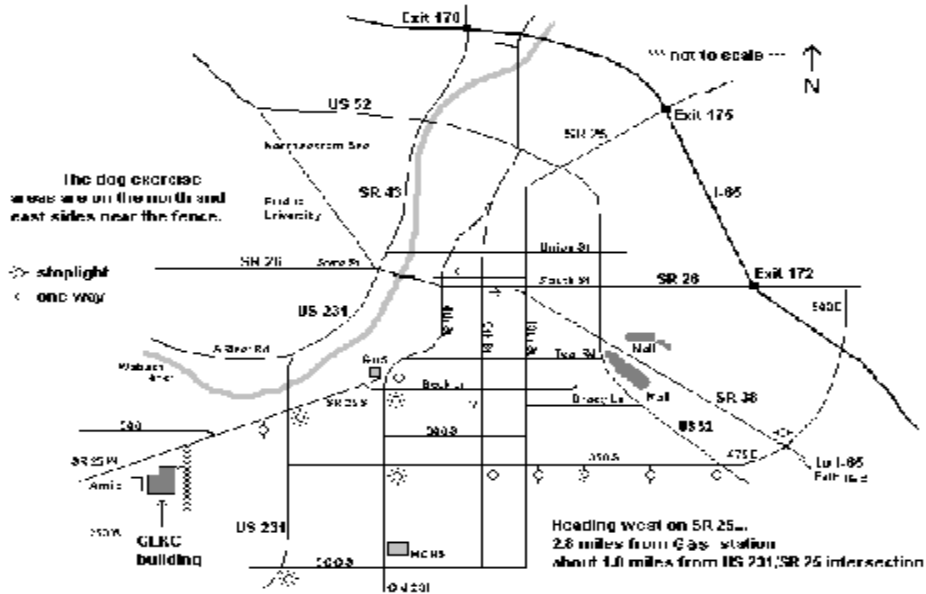

Prizes and Awards

Each dog entered will receive a dog toy or treat (value ≤ \$2.00). Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height in each class (dogs must qualify to receive a placement). Qualifying ribbons and Q cookies will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. On Sat, High Scoring dog in Nov A and a Jr. Handler in Standard classes will receive a basket of dog toys and treats (value ≤ \$10). On Sun, High Scoring dog in Nov A and a Jr. handler in the JWW classes will receive a basket of dog toys and treats (value ≤ \$10). A MACH or PAX bar and rosette will be awarded to those dogs earning one at this trial. All dogs finishing a title will receive a New Title ribbon. All prizes to be claimed the day of the trial, none will be mailed.

Classes and Divisions

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.

Jump Height Divisions

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes.

Regular Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height

Preferred The following jump heights **must** be used in all Preferred Classes.

	REGULAR	PREFERRED
Dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	8 inches	4 inches
Dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	12 inches	8 inches
Dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	16 inches	12 inches
Dogs 22 inches and under at the withers	20 inches	16 inches
Dogs over 22 inches	24 inches	20 inches

Dogs may be entered at 26" height at their owner's discretion.

Height Cards

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

**** NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ****

- * Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- * It is expressly understood exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fee paid will be made. Any incidents of dog aggression resulting in harm to other dogs or people that occur within the show grounds will be reported by the Show Committee to the proper authorities.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- * All dogs **MUST** be on-leash, crated, securely penned, or otherwise under physical control at all times when not competing or at the practice jump. Crating space is limited, please crate in designated areas only.
- * There may be no more than **10 dogs** per entry envelope.
- * No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by means of riot, civil disturbance, fire, or an act of God, emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- * Dogs are not required to be at the Trial until scheduled time of judging; however, exhibitors are responsible for being at the ringside when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Please check in with the Gate Steward.
- * Refunds: A refund of 100% of the entry fees will be given for any reason, if the request is received by the Trial Sec, in writing or emailed, prior to closing. After closing and prior to trial starting, entry fees (less administrative, judging and AKC fees) will be refunded for: injured dogs, injured handlers, and bitches in season (when a letter from your veterinarian is presented before 8:00 am the first day of the trial). A doctor/vet's letter may be required for injuries, at the discretion of the Trial Committee. Requests for refunds received after the start of the trial will not be given for any reason.
- * In accordance with *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, no dogs under the age of 6 months are allowed on the show site. All AKC rules apply regarding toys and food in the ring.
- * If you include an email address, you agree to be contacted about your entry and will check it in a timely manner!

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
